Fatal Drug Overdoses Down Overall

For the first time in decades, <u>drug</u> overdose deaths declined in the U.S., according to <u>the latest numbers from the National</u> <u>Center for Health Statistics</u>.


In 2018, there were 67,367 fatal overdoses – a 4.1% drop from 2017 when there were 70,237 deaths.

While overall drug deaths are down, deaths due to synthetic opioids, like <u>fentanyl</u>, jumped 10% – from 0.9% to 9.9% – between 2017 and 2018.

In addition, cocaine deaths increased about 27% each year from 2012 through 2018. Read the full report.
